\* Some men's voices should sing in the highest register possible. In the chord, they may sing **8va** to create a more powerful, dramatic conclusion. Basses should sing the high C (middle C) and nothing lower. The most comfortable but powerful, highest pitch should be the option and the goal of each singer.
